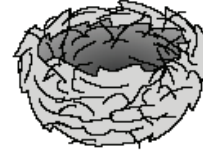

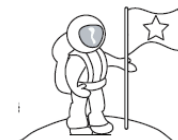

### Spiders

- 1) Many people are afraid of spiders. They think spiders are scary because of their many legs and the way they move. Some spiders can bite, and a few of them are poisonous (سامة). But most spiders are harmless and help us by eating insects. Spiders can be strange in many ways, but this does not make them scary.
- 2) Spiders can live almost anywhere in the world. They live in forests, deserts, and inside our homes. Some spiders build webs in corners of rooms. Others live in gardens or trees. Each type of spider has a special place where it likes to live. Most of them live on land but some live underwater. **They** use special air bubbles to live inside of.
- 3) Spiders are carnivores, which means they eat meat. They eat insects like flies, mosquitoes, and beetles. Some larger spiders can eat small animals like birds or lizards. Many spiders make sticky webs. They use these webs to catch their food. When an insect flies into a web, it cannot escape, and the spider can then eat it. Other spiders use different ways to catch their food.
- 4) There are many interesting facts about spiders that make them special. For example, spiders have blue blood! Their blood is blue because of the copper (نحاس) in it. Another fun fact is that spiders don't have bones inside their bodies. Instead, they have a hard outer shell called an exoskeleton. Also, some spiders can make themselves look like ants to trick other animals. This helps them stay safe from other animals that can eat them.
