They also want to know new things, and talking about what you are studying helps you to understand it better.
- **(5)** The internet is another place to get help. There are websites, videos, and games that can help you understand difficult ideas. You can ask your parents which sites on the internet are best for extra support.
- (6) There are many people who can help you, but what is the best way to ask? It's easy! All you need to say is, "Can you help me, please?" The answer will always be something like, "I would love to!" or "I will if I can!" People love to help students who are interested in learning!
