1) Ants are very small insects that live all around the world. You might see ants in your backyard, in the park, or in your house. Some ants are red, some are black, and some are yellow. There are fire ants, carpenter ants, and leafcutter ants.



2) Ants live in big groups called colonies. Some colonies have thousands or even millions of ants. Each colony has a nest, the home where **they** live. The nest can be underground, in trees, or under rocks.

3) The ants in a colony do different things. Queen ants are the biggest ants in the colony. Their job is to lay eggs and make more ants. The worker ants build the ant nest and find food for the colony. They also take care of the eggs and the baby ants. Soldier (الجنود) ants have only one job. They keep the ant colony safe. They do not allow other insects in. They are bigger and stronger than the worker ants.

4) Only 5 to 10 percent (بالمائة) of ants are soldier ants. So, most ants in the colony are worker ants. They are very good at working together. They work as a team to build their nests. They build their nests in the dirt, in trees, inside old logs, or above ground. They also work as a team to make sure their colony is safe and comfortable.
